

How to import your CMS installation into Softaculous

If you use some CMS like Joomla, WordPress or any other, and for some reasons didn't use Softaculous for its installation, you can still import it into Softaculous to gain all the benefits it provides, like automatic backup and update functions.

Please, follow the steps below.

1. First click on the **Import** Tab on the Software page in cPanel > Softaculous.
2. Then write the name of the directory where it is installed manually or by other auto installer(for eg: **wp**). And then click on the **Import** button to import an Installation.
3. After clicking on the Import icon, the software will be imported to Softaculous and then you can manage the upgrades, backups etc for the installation.
